

What are housing associations?

Housing associations are independent, not-for-profit social businesses that provide homes and support services for their tenants.

Key advice

- Apply for a housing association home through your council's waiting list
- Ask a housing association if it has its own list you can apply to join
- Applying for a rented housing association place

If you want to get a rented housing association home, you will normally have to apply to go on a waiting list. In most areas, there is a central system for deciding who gets all council and housing association homes, but some housing associations also keep their own separate waiting lists.
